Hungarian maestro Andras Schiff returns to the UK for one week only

November 19, 2012, 11:03 am -- /[EPR NETWORK](#)/ -- One of the world's most revered pianists and interpreters of Beethoven and Mozart, Andras Schiff, returns to the UK this month for another crack at his much-lauded 'piano Everest' endeavour of playing all of Beethoven's piano sonatas chronologically.

First achieving the feat in 2006, the event was deemed a triumph by publications such as The Independent. This time around, The Sunday Times has been talking up tickets as in the 'gold-dust' category; you might be lucky to get one of the remaining seats for Monday November 19th.

Playing at the Wigmore Hall in central London, a space praised for its acoustics and atmosphere especially conducive to recitals, Hungarian composer and pianist Andras Schiff will be gracing the stage for one week, from November 19th to the 26th.
