

'Evolution of the Nude' video banned in Bolivia, Cameroon and Nepal despite Award

Press Release Summary: Three minute video wins Humanita award, but runs afoul of national censors

Press Release Body: A short video available on common video sites, (<http://www.youtube.com/watch?v=gpRHwIIPFM>) has won an award for educational content, but has been banned in three countries.

"**Evolution of the Nude**" by the **MissionArtGroup** details the history of depictions of the female form in art over the last 3000 years. Each image morphs into the next one, giving a fuzzy feeling of having seen artistic history progress from the Venus de Milo to the present.

Though the video won the **Humanita Award**, given to short internet videos which convey significant educational content, it has been banned in countries where even artistic depictions of the naked body are in questionable taste.

The **MissionArtGroup** is considering whether to re-edit the work to make it more acceptable, but the existing version will remain online for some time.
