Photography enters the classic gallery for the first time, with its Seduced By Art collection – LondonTown.com offers West End hotel deals for interested London visitors

October 22, 2012, 6:34 am -- /[EPR NETWORK](#)/ -- For art lovers and photography buffs, the National Gallery's autumn 2012 exhibition is an exciting prospect. From October 31st, Seduced by Art: Photography Past and Present will be in the West End, taking an inquisitive look at the strong links between several modern photographers and 19th century art.

As well as thematic pairings, bringing landscape photography into relief with lush painted landscapes from the National Gallery collection, there will also be – for the first time – three 'interventions' of contemporary photographs by Richard Billingham, Craigie Horsfield and Richard Learoyd. These will be displayed within the Gallery's collection,

juxtaposed with 19th-century paintings by Constable, Degas and Ingres.
