King of Pop resurrected by Cirque du Soleil, with five London dates announced at O2 Arena

October 04, 2012, 2:09 pm -- /<u>EPR NETWORK</u>/ -- Three years after his untimely death, the music and magic of Michael Jackson is returning to the stage thanks to world-renowned avant-garde performance troupe Cirque du Soleil. Entitled 'Michael Jackson: The Immortal World Tour', the show will come to London this month, running at the O2 Arena from October 12th -16th.

Jackson was purportedly fascinated by the French-Canadian group of visual artists, whose shows – including the Beatles-inspired Vegas mainstay 'Love' - are eagerly anticipated by a global fanbase. Jackson was an early devotee, seeing them perform in LA during the late 80s, and regularly took his children to see the troupe in their native Montreal.

The new show, written and directed by Emmy-winner Jamie King, will tour North America and Europe during 2012 and 2013. Tickets for the London shows range from forty to one hundred pounds, with shows kicking off at 8pm. Helping traveling fans of Jackson and Cirque du Soleil stay in London at reduced room rates is website LondonTown.com, who have partnered with a number of London hotels near the O2 Arena to offer discounts.

Among the discounted hotels on offer, the <u>Radisson Blu Edwardian</u> <u>New Providence Wharf</u> – just fifteen minutes walk from the O2 Arena – has announced double rooms from £62, an 88% discount on the usual rate. The <u>Ibis London Docklands</u> is offering double rooms from £ 87 per night, a 44% discount on the usual nightly rate. The Ibis is less than 15 minutes walk from the O2 Arena, and overlooks the world famous Canary Wharf.

Also on offer are discounts on double and twin rooms at the Holiday Inn Express in Greenwich. The Holiday Inn Express is offering a 77% discount, bringing the cost of a night's stay down to just £ 57.
