In the second BPL season, which ended on December 31, 2008, over two hundred participants competed for the title of BPL Champion. It was a close, competitive season until the last few weeks when BPL member Frankie opened up a significant lead, which he maintained until the end to claim the title. Among the 200+ participants Frankie defeated to win the BPL crown was the reigning champion from the BPL's inaugural season. For his efforts, Frankie was awarded prizes including a boxing logo T-shirt and a boxing DVD. The first and second runners up - Adrenalkrome and jade - also received prizes.

The BPL's third season kicks off on Saturday, January 17, 2009, with Andre Berto's defense of the WBC Welterweight Title against Luis Collazo.
