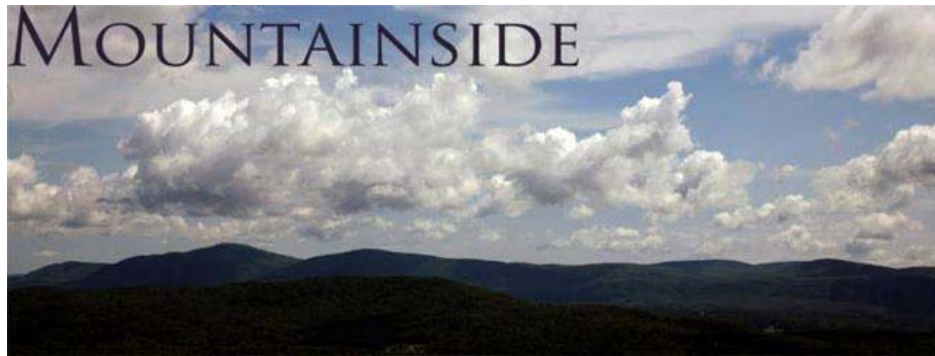


# Connecticut Drug Rehab Announces Changes Within Its Facility
